• Insight [G, Confidence: Moderate]: The use of terrorism as a state policy by Pakistan against India is a long-standing issue, with recent reports emphasizing the need for continued vigilance and diplomatic efforts.

Credibility: The insight is based on historical data and expert reports.

Coherence: The narrative aligns with historical tensions and geopolitical dynamics in the region.

Confidence: Moderate, given the reliance on historical analysis and expert opinion.

• Insight [R, Confidence: High]: The ongoing austerity measures in Australia could undermine national security capabilities, particularly in law enforcement and counterterrorism efforts.

Credibility: The insight is supported by statements from relevant unions and government officials.

Coherence: The information is consistent with known budgetary constraints and security needs.

Confidence: High, given the direct statements from involved parties and the alignment with

known fiscal policies.
